Dear Colleague,

In response to popular demand we are offering the Mini- Residency program again. This program is appropriate for those who have not attended our previous Mini-Residency programs. This series of seminars will enhance your ability to deliver high quality, predictable, implant and tooth supported restorative dentistry to your patients. The goal of this intensive study program is to provide clinicians with new and expanded tools that allow them to treatment plan and execute restorative dental procedures with greater ease and improved predictability. In this program attention is focused on both tooth supported and implant supported restorative concepts and procedures. While these are lofty sounding goals past experiences has proven that these goals can be accomplished. We will teach you a skill set that will allow you to increase your gross and net income.
