

Dear Doctor,

Welcome, as we begin the 2011–2012 lecture series of The Restorative Dental Study Club of Cambridge. We will kick off the year on Wednesday evening, October 5th with Dr. Roger Wise.

We are fortunate to have Dr. Roger Wise as our speaker. *He is one of a small number of dental specialists in the world fully trained and Board Eligible in both Periodontics and Orthodontics.* He has presented over 200 lectures throughout the U.S. and abroad on Adult Orthodontics and the Interrelationship of Periodontics, Orthodontics and Restorative Dentistry. He has written four textbook chapters and has authored numerous papers in refereed journals.

His topic will be: **Management of Dental Alveolar Trauma**

The treatment of dental alveolar trauma should be a multidisciplinary discussion. Early mixed-dentition injuries ranging from simple displacements to advanced intrusions and avulsions will be described in detail with special emphasis on the role of each team member. Similar injuries in the adult dentition will be differentiated. Implant placement, combined with hard and soft tissue management and restoration, will be demonstrated. Participants will be enlightened by the stable and esthetic results achievable when the focus is always from a multidisciplinary approach in the esthetic zone.

1. Learn the effects of trauma on orthodontic treatment
2. How to provide the best possible outcomes with a team approach
3. Understand treatment outcomes for specific injuries
