Implant Design for the 21st Century

Paul Fletcher DDS, is a periodontist who practices in New York City and is a partner in Specialized Dentistry of New York, a group implant, cosmetic specialty practice. Paul is a senior partner with Dr's. Tarnow, Chu and Smith and co-author of the landmark paper on the 5mm. papilla rule with Dr. Tarnow.

He is an Associate Clinical Professor at the Columbia University College of Dental Medicine where he teaches periodontics and implant dentistry on a post-graduate level. Dr. Fletcher has had more than two dozen papers published in the dental literature and has lectured on periodontal prosthetics and implant dentistry both nationally and internationally.
